



MARI'S DESIGN TIP

Create your own gift bag with dies and all your artistic creativity! Mari embraced her artsy side and went to town with rub-ons and paint on a natural base.

TAG TIP: Make the tag stand out by choosing a neutral base. This allows the poinsettia and greenery that Mari added to her tag to be the star of the show. Notice how she inked the edges to reflect the artsy style of the gift bag.

TAG TIP: Since tags don't need to be tucked into an envelope, feel free to add dimension and chunk. This tag and gift will look so pretty under the tree!



PRODUCT HIGHLIGHT: Floral builder die sets like this one from **Spellbinders** are such a fun way to decorate a festive tag.



CATHY'S DESIGN TIP

Make the tag the star. Even if your package is small like this darling pillow box from Lawn Fawn, don't be afraid to play up the tag with stamped, die-cut, and coloured critters.

TAG TIP: Limit your colour palette.

Using a monochromatic patterned paper and cardstock lets the sweet little birds really pop off the tag.

TAG TIP: Die cut an extra tag and adhere to the back of the first tag

but flip it so it almost looks like it seals the tag together. This technique adds sturdiness to the tag.

pocket play

Short on time? Here you'll find creative ideas to make the most of your memory keeping minutes. BY KIMBERLY CHAFFIN

Hello, crafty friends, I'm Kim! When I first began scrapbooking about 25 years ago, pocket pages were not the norm. Once pocket scrapbooking came onto the scene, I thought it was such a clever idea, but I was afraid the pockets might be limiting. Since then, I've learned that with pocket pages your imagination is your only limit. Indeed, they are ideal for capturing a week at a glance. But I tend to use pocket pages to tell the story of an event, to document changes through the years, and even to house a traditional layout cropped into pocket-sized pieces. My albums are an eclectic mix of pocket pages of varying sizes and full-sized layouts, and, for me, that expands my creative potential and adds to the fun! If you haven't given pockets a try, I encourage you to open a new door in your memory keeping and see where it leads!



POCKET TIP #1: Pick one colour. A monochromatic colour scheme helps to tie a layout together. I stuck with mostly pink, which was inspired by the colour of my daughter's ski pants and earmuffs in the photos.

POCKET TIP #2: Keep it simple. Lots of white space gives the eye plenty of room to rest. Though there is a lot of white in this snowy layout, white space—the part of the page that remains bare—can be any colour.

Tell the story with repetition. By using the word Today on each of my three journaling cards, I give myself a common jumping off point for my writing, and from a design standpoint, the repeated element looks so nice!

TIPS

POCKET TIP #1: Mesh traditional and pocket scrapbooking. When placing a full-sized layout in several pockets, I think of it like putting together a puzzle. The fun is in playing around and figuring out where to place each piece. I look for a part of the photo that I can remove for my journaling card.

POCKET TIP #2: Play with puzzle pieces. You can start with a 12 x 12 photo (or any size) and cut it into the appropriate pocket sizes. If you don't have the capability to print that large of a photo, you can crop the picture into 4 x 6 chunks in your photo-editing software and print the layout in pieces.

POCKET TIP #3: Lead the eye. I've placed my phrase strips and other embellishments in a triangle arrangement to create a pleasing path for the eye to follow on my page.



Dare to cross over the pocket lines. It's one of my favourite techniques! Embellishments and photos don't need to be confined to one pocket. Simply place the item where you want it by adhering it so that it hangs over an edge. Then trim along the edge and adhere the excess to the photo in the adjacent pocket.

design 101

Let's study the hows and whys that separate just okay design from great design! BY SUSAN R. OPEL

Want to know why it works when a design comes together? Delve into the minds of four creative designers to learn some fantastic rules for making your next project a phenomenal success!

layout 1

Homemade touches. Add some stitching for that little something special.

Keep it tight.

Mari nestled her elements tightly together with open space around the elements which creates a cohesive design. There are no strange, trapped spaces in between elements on her layout.

BIG DESIGN TIP: Mari wanted to complement the colours in her photos, and she found that this floral paper was the perfect starting point. See how the citrus nestled in the floral paper really draws the eye to the warm yellow winter coat in the top photo. The other papers were chosen to enhance the dominant photo colours in a subtle fashion.

Add harmony to your design by repeating similar elements like the Christmas florals.

christmas magic

Consider your alignment.

The dark mat on the layout paired with the red patterned paper creates a frame, and the vertical alignment of the photos and papers is pleasing to the eye.

Create visual interest with patterned papers. The papers used vary from very busy to subtle, allowing the eye to rest in the quieter spots.

Balance it out.

The placement of photos connects the elements in the diagonal line in the center of the layout.

Make it flow. Give movement to your design by adding elements on the diagonal like Mari did with the ephemera clusters and her title.

Size matters. Make sure your photos fit inside the circle frame. This ensures that the circle is not lost in the design, and the images are still at the center of the layout.

Play with shapes. Create a large circle in a contrasting colour to the background to bring attention to the photos in the circle. The simple white frame around the circle emphasizes and enhances the focal point.

layout 2

Emphasize the shape. Cluster your embellishments around the circumference of the shape to add emphasis.

Choose a coordinating cardstock to match your patterned paper to create the base of the page. This allows the page to have a bit of contrast while still having enough of a neutral base for the eye to rest.



Finish it up. Add enamel dots around the circumference of the circle frame in order to emphasize the shape and give movement to the circle.

happiness is homemade

BY NATHALIE DESOUSA

Frame the shape by adding your florals on opposing sides of the circle. Doing this brings balance to the layout and interest to the photo.

BIG DESIGN TIP: Give your layout a solid foundation by anchoring your page and title. Nathalie brought in a piece of the patterned paper at the top of the page with a subtle scalloped border at the bottom of the page. The scalloped border both softens the bottom edge and brings a subtle roundness to the base of the page. Get inspired by products. One part of this pretty Christmas collection was an embellishment that Flóra loved so much that she created her own version as a super-sized floral Christmas tree. Make a big impact. Create a main decorative element by using a cut file. The tree makes quite a statement and anchors the main elements of the layout.

layout 3

Choose a portrait or selfie. With the dominant tree on the layout, a portrait makes a better focal point as it includes faces which the viewer will seek out.

Make the photo pop by adding a frame or patterned paper layers under your photos.

Embrace the elegance of **Christmas** by adding gold accent stickers to emphasize the special and uplifting qualities of Christmas.



BIG DESIGN TIP: White space makes the world go 'round. Some of us have to fight the urge to fill every last inch of space on a layout or card design with all the things! Flóra's layout is proof that white space (showing up here in the form of a subtle pink patterned paper) can be a very good thing. It allows us to see the photo, read the journaling, and appreciate the beautiful and stately Christmas tree!

Vary your patterned paper choices. For the background, Flóra used a B-side paper with small patterns to showcase the elements and to be a foil to the busy and bold patterns of the tree and the perimeter.

Create texture by layering die cuts and stickers. Use foam tape to create depth.

Dilay saw the need for a little something more, so she used a paintbrush to apply gold paint for a subtle sparkle. It's magic!

DESIGN TIP: When making a shaped card, die cut two identical shapes. On one of the dies, make a score line a ½ inch from the top. Apply adhesive above the score line and adhere to the matching die. If you are using a die where it has a sharp point at the end like a heart, trim just enough so that the card can stand up on its own.

OUR FOCUS: ANYTHING BUT A RECTANGLE

We asked five designers to create cards in a variety of shapes, and boy, did they deliver! Their ideas will have you exploring all the possibilities. Let's see how things shape up!

HAVE A HEART

When it comes to shaped cards,

DESIGN TIP: One thing to consider is card size. Do you have an envelope that will work? If push comes to shove, it's so cute it doesn't matter! Hand deliver the card or place inside a gift bag without an envelope.

DESIGN TIP: Shaped card dies like this one from The Stamps of Life are fancy. They tell you where to line up your fold when it's time to cut.

DESIGN TIP: Take Mindy's idea and run with it!

Create several versions of this design in different monochromatic colour combinations OR use the whole rainbow to create a pretty church window.

DESIGN TIP: A little bit of shimmer from foil amps up the Christmas sparkle.

DESIGN TIP: Make your heat embossed sentiments more prominent by double heat embossing them. This works best if you use a stamp positioner so that you can go back and stamp in the same place to add more embossing powder for dimension.

DESIGN TIP: Try this same shape in a vertical orientation. To allow it to stand up, slice the curve off the back of the card base to make it a straight line. This way the card can lean back on that line and not topple over.



Tuck them among the greenery on your mantel, showcase them on a shelf or the coffee table, or line them up side-by-side on a credenza. Having your mini albums easily accessible will encourage your family and friends to peruse them and enjoy the memories of Christmases gone by.

GETTING STARTED

Don't get your tinsel in a tangle. Before you begin, choose a collection to work with or create a kit from your supplies. Having everything pulled together and ready to go will make the creative process smoother and more enjoyable.

The variety of page protectors available for 6 x 8 albums gives me a lot of versatility—like the ability to highlight a special photo on a full 6 x 8 canvas or create a fold-out insert to accommodate additional photos. I also love that I can add or reorder the pages since I sometimes receive additional photos from my family members after the fact. I can easily incorporate these into my existing album design with the snap binding.

MINI TIP: Love at frost sight. A beautiful mini album cover will draw the reader in and set the stage for what's inside. Create a design around a favourite piece from the collection or add a unique and eye-catching detail.

MINI TIP: Make a list and check it twice.

Look through your photos and select the ones you want to include. Then sketch out the pages and decide where each photo will go. This helps you edit and print your photos in the sizes that you'll need. Now that the prep work is done, it's time to create!

MINI TIP: 'Tis the season to **sparkle.** Be sure to incorporate something sparkly in your mini album to make it feel extra special. The shine from epoxy, metalrimmed brads, and clear gems in my project helps to make each recorded moment feel magical.

MINI TIP: All spruced up.

Add variety and dimension to your mini album by creating additional festive die cuts with a manual die. I used dies from Spellbinders to add pine sprigs, holly leaves, and poinsettias to accent the ephemera I used throughout my album.

MINI TIP: #KeepItSimpleSanta.

If your family is anything like mine, your holiday activities tend to repeat themselves year after year. I tend to keep my journaling simple and choose to focus on the moments that were unique to that specific year. If you need additional space for journaling, write it on a tag and tuck it behind a photo-turned-pocket, or type it on an additional card and add it as an insert.

- Place the rosettes in a wreath and then feature a photo in the center of the wreath.
- Add a title at the top around a curved part.
- Embellish with coordinating ephemera and stickers.
- Sprinkle enamel dots around the page to finish!


