


Maya Road's kraft envelopes serve double duty as both a place to hide my journaling and a fun element to alter and embellish.

Used by cardmakers for delivering their beautiful creations, envelopes and postage stamps are no longer solely for correspondence. Now they make trendy additions to scrapbook pages. Envelopes are showing up in different sizes, with unique closures, and sporting decorative edges. There are so many ways to use them. They can hold hidden journaling, like I did on my page. Try binding them together to create an album, or even go for ready-made. And why not use an envelope simply as

a decorative element? A companion to the envelope, the postage stamp comes in many crafty varieties: chipboard, stickers, paper, die-cuts, acrylic stamps, punches, and borders, just to name a few. With the popularity of the scalloped edge, it was only a matter of time before the iconic stamp's reverse scallop made its way into scrapbooking. All this being said, you're still welcome to use envelopes and stamps for their original purpose. Just make sure the stamp is from the post office.



I love the chunky, chipboard stamps from **Cosmo Cricket's** Circa 1934 collection.



The elastic band that holds these **Stampin' Up!** gusset envelopes closed is a great twist on unique closures.

Authentic cancelled stamp images from **BasicGrey** will add elegance and vintage appeal to any project.



This banker's envelope and tag album by **Melissa Frances** is perfect for tucking away journaling and memorabilia.



For a quick "make-your-own-stamp," **Martha Stewart's** one-squeeze punch is just the ticket.



to her photos. Her "before and after" journaling, broken into two sections, rests on matching tags which hold smaller photos that support the story.





got scraps?

turn leftover scraps into BEAUTIFUL cards!

Always a reader favourite, our "Got Scraps" article shows quick and practical ways to use up your scrap stash. And, as an added bonus, we've included handy card sketches from PageMaps.

instructions

1. Cut dark blue cardstock to 4.25" wide x 11" long. Fold it in half to create a card base, with the opening at the bottom.
2. Paint a scrap of white cardstock with blue acrylic paint. Let dry. Punch out seven 1" circles with a paper punch and adhere them to the top of the card as shown.
3. Cut the stripe paper 4" x .75". Attach it to the top of the card, covering the bottom half of the seven circles.
4. Cut a piece of green script paper 4" x 4". Attach it to the card under the striped paper.
5. Wrap the front of the card with floss and tie it off in a knot as shown.
6. Adhere a large polka dot button, chipboard snowflake, green button and "BRR" sticker.
7. Run vellum through a printer to print sentiment. Attach the vellum to the card as shown.
8. Punch a snowflake from the green and blue dot paper. Cut it in half and attach each half to edges of card as shown. Adhere pearls in the center.




Leftover patterned paper, stacked one on top of the other, created a beautiful base for Danielle's wintery card. The snow-capped scallops are the crowning touch, and isn't that green button just beautiful?

there's snow-body like you

by DANIELLE FLANDERS

supplies CARDSTOCK, Craft Supply; PATTERNED PAPER, BUTTONS, Jenni Bowlin Studio; STICKER, CHIPBOARD SNOWFLAKE, PEARLS, Melissa Frances; VELLUM, Glue Arts; ADHESIVE, Glue Arts; FONT, Edwardian Script; EMBROIDERY FLOSS



instructions

1. Make a 4.25" x 5.5" card from kraft card stock. Ink the edges with brown chalk ink.
2. Trim a 4" x 5.25" cream piece from Snow Day and adhere it to the center of the card stock.
3. Trim a kraft Tag to 4" long, ink edges. Tie red baker's twine through the top of the tag. Adhere to the front of the card.
4. Adhere a Joy die cut from Christmas Chestnut Soup to the front of the tag.
5. Adhere a chipboard snowflake from Tinsel and Twig to the front of the tag.




Kimber layered leftover die-cuts onto a tag, topped off with multiple loops of baker's twine. The crepe paper and tinsel center of the chipboard snowflake gives the card a lot of homespun appeal.



instructions

1. Make the base of the card out of brown cardstock to a finished size of 4.25" x 5.5".
2. Cut journal card to fit as shown. Ink edges. Adhere to card leaving the left side open to add twine.
3. Slip in twine and wrap. Finish by threading in a button and tying a bow on top. Adhere down rest of journal card to secure twine.
4. Cut a strip of pink cardstock. Cut a "v" into left end. Ink edges and adhere letter stickers. Adhere to card.

One half of a journaling card, leftover from another project, made a great background element for Greta's card. A pink banner, which holds a sentiment spelled out from orphan letter stickers, is a nice contrast to the brown and aqua colours.

Put those scraps to work and create a one-of-a-kind, handmade card yourself!



As scrapbooking has evolved over the years, so have the products we work with. The simple shapes that are punched from cardstock are not just for adorning the bulletin board in your child's classroom. Die-cuts have transformed into elaborate, intricate shapes, in hundreds of

colours, and with a variety of tactile surfaces. With the growing popularity of other mediums such as chipboard, felt, corrugated cardstock and canvas, die-cuts have been taken to a whole new level. Here are five fun ways to take them over the top.




1 die-cutting machines
Die-cutting machines have not only become affordable, but portable as well. And if you are like me, you are always looking for creative, new ideas to try with die-cuts. I am huge fan of adding dimension to my layouts. To make your die-cuts jump off the page, cut multiples of your favourite shape and glue them one on top of another to create a faux chipboard look. The snowflakes on this layout were created by layering eight pieces together. I used a Crop-A-Dile to punch holes in the center of my snowflakes, and then adorned them with over-sized brads.

Summer's yellow snowflakes really stand out against the trendy, unexpected colour palette of her bold, wintery layout. Corrugated letters, with their tips dipped in white paint, create a fantastic faux snow effect.



die-cuts by the sheet

Many manufacturers produce 6"x12" and 12"x12" sheets of both punch-out and self-adhesive die-cuts, all of them loaded with a host of shapes and designs. Although they are terrific as is, here are some simple techniques to dress them up and add a personalized touch.

- Highlight the curves and contours of an image with hand stitching
- For added interest, accent images with self-adhesive rhinestones, pearls, brads or buttons
- Create a 3D effect by simply adhering die-cuts to a layout or card using dimensional adhesive such as foam dots
- Layer multiple die-cuts to tell a story just like I did on my "Dear Santa" card



texturize die-cut chipboard

Summer added texture to her kitchen chipboard shapes by lightly misting them with water, placing them in an embossing folder, and running the wet pieces through a die-cut machine (such as a Cuttlebug). Once dry, she then painted the pieces to match her layout.

To enhance the raised embossing, Summer chose a darker shade of red ink and ran the pad over the top of each piece to highlight the bubble dots. This same technique works great with paper die-cuts by simply skipping the water misting step.



a baker's dozen

Have you ever bought a set of multiple die-cuts because you really loved one image, only to find yourself wondering how you would use the rest of the package? Try Kimber's approach and use an entire set on one layout. With a package of pre-printed tags, Kimber created an eye-catching background image. By adding simple touches, like twine and scalloped edges, she unified the die-cuts and produced an "easy to scraplift" page.

Look closely at the poinsettia and cup of cocoa. For added dimension, Kimber trimmed out these shapes from duplicate tags and attached them to the matching tag with foam dots. Her journaling tag stands out, too, with the help of a dark green cardstock mat.

Like most of us, you probably have a stash of leftover die-cuts from a variety of manufacturers. Mix an assortment of shapes from your surplus, as I have done for this frame, to create a one-of-a-kind project. I accented the chipboard bells with glitter glue and machine-stitched a frame around a piece of die-cut notebook paper.

Summer did not remove the release paper on the back of the self-adhesive chipboard bells, so they could hang freely from the center of the flower.

Packing tape is a great way to add glitter to your projects when you want to cover a large area. For this card, I cut out a circle from the front flap, then placed a strip of packing tape over the opening on the inside, front flap. I closed the card and rubbed glitter over the tacky side of the tape.

let it snow

supplies CARD, STAMPS, Hero Arts; PATTERNED PAPER, Studio Calico; BRADS, American Crafts; GLITTER, Maya Road; INK, Ranger Industries; MARKERS, Copic; ADHESIVE, 3L; packing tape

After stamping the original image with ink, I then pressed the stamp onto a glue ink pad and offset stamped the image again. I applied ultra-fine glitter to the image while it was still wet.

photography for today's scrapper:

How Do I? When Would I? Why Should I? BY KATHY THOMPSON LAFFOLEY

Capture the magic of the season in your photos, both outside and indoors, with these great tips from our shutterbug friend, Kathy.

As a child, I remember sitting spellbound the first time I saw *The Nutcracker*, right before Christmas. The whole production was beautiful, but the sparkling white winter scene was by far my favourite. Fast forward (quite) a few years later and I was once again transported to that beautiful winter wonderland as I watched my own daughter perform in the same ballet.

Capturing Outdoor White

As much as we often love to hate winter, a crisp, bright, sparkly winter day is hard to beat! That is, until you try to take photos and capture all of that pure whiteness. Why is it that when your eye sees clean and sparkly and white, your camera captures dull and grey? That's because your camera is just trying to help you out!



this little light of mine

Cameras are simply computers, doing their very best to capture the "average." Your camera takes a reading of the average light in a scene, and when that scene consists of a lot of very white and highly reflective snow, it assumes there is a lot more light than there actually is, so it tries to average things out for you. The result is often dingy, underexposed pictures.

SCT • the 3T's

If you haven't ventured away from your camera's automatic settings yet, that's okay. Most point-and-shoot cameras actually have a 'snow' or a 'beach' setting that will help to counteract some of the extra reflection. If that doesn't work, try fooling your camera a bit by focusing on something not quite so white (your subject's skin is usually ideal) and then carefully recomposing your shot, and then press the shutter down completely.

If you are shooting in Aperture or Shutter Priority, or Manual Mode (if these terms are Greek to you, your owner's manual will have references for them), and your scene includes a lot of snow, then try overexposing by an f-stop or two so that the white snow you see is indeed the white snow you capture. Meter off of whatever is close to a medium grey in your photo, and check your histogram. And don't forget to check your white balance.



Capturing Indoor Lights

Holidays aren't your only opportunity to capture sparkly lights; this technique works beautifully with a birthday cake full of candles, or even a row of home decor candles as I've shot here.

If you are a scrapbooker who loves sparkle, there are some beautiful products on the market to enhance the twinkle that you've captured with your camera. There's something magical about the starburst from the lights in your photograph. That twinkle inspired the title of my layout.

As the winter season is fast approaching, be ready to wake up to freshly fallen snow any day now. Head outside with your camera, seize it in all its white glory, and then come in, make some hot chocolate, light a few candles and capture the sparkle!

Twinkling Tips

- * Set your camera to manual mode.
- * Suggested settings: ISO 100, f/22 and a very slow shutter speed, such as 30 seconds.
- * In order to support such a slow shutter speed, you will need to put your camera on a tripod. If you do not have a tripod, place your camera on something sturdy such as a table.
- * A remote works great if you have one, otherwise use the self-timer feature of your camera.
- * Make sure the room is as dark as possible, with only the lights you are photographing turned on.
- * Now, compose your shot, take the photo and move away from the camera.



Now in Kentucky is a pretty rare event, so a significant snowfall is always a cause for celebration, especially if it cancels school for the day! Snow days are filled with sledding, snowball fights and snow angels. And such a rare occurrence has to be documented, right? The beautiful aqua, cherry red, and dark chocolate colours of BasicGrey's Jovial line ended up being the perfect paper choice for my three layouts.



supplies PATTERNED PAPER, ALPHA STICKERS, BRADS, DIE-CUTS, RUB-ONS, BasicGrey: SCALLOP BORDER PUNCH, CIRCLE PUNCH, Fiskars: SNOWFLAKE PUNCH, EK Success: ADHESIVE, 3L; FONT, Times New Roman

For my **easy** layout, I maintained simple, linear lines so the focus would be on the fun, bright photos of my boys. To further emphasize the photos, I matted them with bright red paper and placed them within the visual triangle created between the lower left snowflake, the upper snowflake and the die-cut book label. I added a few punched shapes and brads for added interest and to reinforce the theme of the page.



For my **detailed** layout, I wanted to add more texture and dimension. I began by embossing my title block, then layered die-cut elements in the title with pop dots and chipboard shapes, like the “o” in snow and the snowflake die-cuts in “men.” I highlighted the polka dot paper with a few well-placed glazed brads to accent it. Notice how I also created a focal photo in this version by enlarging the middle photo, but equalized the emphasis on all three shots by matting them with the same bright red paper.

For my **expert** layout, I really kicked it up in the details. I rearranged the photos, enlarging one of them for a more energetic look. I curved the edge of the white paper to rest my title on, replacing the “O” with a chipboard snowman. Snowflakes on circles crown the top of the two square photos, and smaller punched snowflakes scatter about the page. Pen details, glitter glaze and jute suspended between two brads wrap up my page with just the right finishing touches to complete this fun, wintery layout.

by ROREE RUMPH

1. Trim a 10.5" x 4.25" piece of green cardstock; fold it in half with the opening at the bottom.
2. Trim a 4.25" x 5.5" piece of pattern paper and sew it to the front of the card. Apply the "joy" sticker to the top, right corner and zig-zag stitch it in place.
3. Stamp a noteblock image onto a 3" x 5.25" piece of light green cardstock; adhere the panel to the left side of the card as shown.
4. Wrap a piece of ribbon around the bottom edge off the card and tie a bow.
5. Hand cut a 1.75" and a 2.5" white circle; trim out a scarf in three pieces as shown; an orange nose, pattern mittens and brown stick arms.
6. Machine sew around the white circles. Distress all edges with a file.
7. Assemble the snowman to the right side of the card as shown. Add two black brads for eyes.
8. Adhere the entire panel to the front of the cardstock base.

2. Stamp the heart image onto a 2"x2" piece of white cardstock.
3. Using Gamsol and paper stumps to blend, colour in the hearts. Start with your darkest colour and blend to a lighter colour. Draw around each heart with a glitter pen.
4. Adhere the stamped image onto a 2.25" x 2.25" piece of white cardstock.
5. Trim a 2.5" x 2.5" piece of light blue cardstock. Sew around the inside edge of the square. Adhere the matted, stamped image to the center of the blue square.
6. Adhere the entire piece to the front of the card. Tie a pink ribbon at the top as shown.

2. Trim a 4" x 5" piece of white cardstock; stamp holiday images and sentiment onto the cardstock in rows as shown, using black ink.
3. Colour in the holiday images using Copic markers; use a white gel pen to draw dots on the presents.
4. Add small, blue buttons to the centers of the snowflakes; tie bows onto the packages using twine; add a brown button/bow to the tree trunk; and apply red gems to the reindeer noses.
5. Adhere the white cardstock panel to the front of the card.

3. Using circle punches, punch out a 2.5" white circle, a 1.5" aqua circle and a 1" light green circle. Referring to the photo, layer the circles along the bottom third of the card.
4. Punch out a 2" light green circle and adhere it to the top of the card, allowing some of the circle to hang off the top edge as shown. Trim the excess circle.
5. Attach a white chipboard snowflake to the aqua circle. Attach three gems to the small green circle. Attach one large and two small gems to the left of the large green circle.
6. Apply the chipboard "Happy Holidays" to the large green circle. Attach the "JOY" chipboard sentiment as shown using dimensional pop dots.

2. Trim a 4" x 5.25" piece of blue cardstock. Using a straight edge ruler and a black pen, draw a solid line around the interior edge of the cardstock as shown.
3. Die-cut two trees, ice skates, a 2" shaped circle and a 1.75" circle.
4. Die-cut one 5" x 1.25" oval and emboss it with a desired pattern.
5. Stamp the skates and socks onto white cardstock and cut out. Colour the blades with Copic markers and apply glitter.
6. Add two bows of twine to the tops of the skates and white pom poms to the ends of the laces.
7. Stamp a sentiment and add gems. Apply the sentiment to the shaped circle.
8. Adhere all elements to the light blue cardstock as shown, using foam dots on the top skate.
9. Adhere the light blue panel to the front of the card.
