DESIGN TIP: You can create something similar by using flower and window dies, and don't forget the cute polka-dotted window box. The window box would be a super cute embellishment on a springtime layout or a darling focal point for a card.

DESIGN TIP: Mix it up by using flower dies, stickers, die cut shapes, or any floral product you can find! Just come up with a colour scheme that will unify everything.
