




go for the grid

Center-weighted designs feel strong and stable, and make it easy to create a balanced layout.




hello water baby





focus on florals

Sidnie created a garden of flowers using this issue's card sketch, and we love the sweet simplicity of her two cards! For her first card, she stayed pretty true to the original sketch with the sentiment in the same place and the bow of baker's twine, though you'll notice that she placed the flower at the top as a lovely design surprise. By choosing subtle, monochromatic green patterned papers, the background accents rather than overpowers the card. Her second card turns the sketch on its side and features a gorgeous floral die from Pink & Main. While Sidnie strayed from the original sketch on this one, you can see that her sentiment is in the shape of the flag like the PageMap and the gorgeous flower is a predominant part of the design.
