#### enlarge and rotate stripes

#### Lisa Dickinson's bold and graphic style gravitated towards Nina-Marie's chic, striped card design.

Lisa enlarged her stripes and created a large design element with patterned papers in the rainbow colours. In addition, Lisa added lots of buttons, stars, and enamel dots to create movement in her design similar to the sequins on Nina-Marie's card.

**DESIGN TIP: Fonts matter!** The word thankful on the card inspired Lisa's script fun in her title with a big swoop on the last letter.

### study angles and focal points

Nathalie DeSousa loved the basic sketch and bones of Latisha Yoast's sweet card design. Nathalie started with a darker toned cardstock frame and a lighter patterned paper with a stitching detail similar to the embossed stitches on Latisha's card. Notice how Nathalie replaced the large heart die cut of the card with a cut file and two photos, and since the card follows a diagonal design, she opted to repeat that with enamel dots and extra florals.

## cards 1 & 2

#### use layouts to inspire cards

#### Latisha Yoast turned the tables for this assignment.

She studied previous issues of SCT and landed on this lovely layout by Lorimar Ortega. Latisha used this layout as inspiration for two card designs. The simpler miss you card incorporates the main elements of the layout on a smaller scale, and in place of the photo, she left quiet space to accentuate the sentiment. Her colour scheme in this card parallels the layout as well. The second card is a little straighter and more rigid than the artistic layout, but there is a fullness to the design with all of the cool embellishments Latisha used to mimic Lorimar's gorgeous photo frame.

DESIGN TIP: Use vellum layers. The vellum panel on this card softens the green cardstock base, creating a calm grounding for the colourful wreath element.

**DESIGN TIP: Choose smaller patterns for your** background layer. Much like the vellum on the first card, a smaller pattern creates a quiet base to contain the other fun card elements.
