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## MEASUREMENTS:

- Strips: $1^{\prime \prime} \times$ varying lengths
- Photo mat: $3 \times 4$ "
- Journaling block: 2-1/2 x 3/4"


## PLACEMENTS

- The strips come together at the middle ( $6^{\prime \prime}$ ) point of the layout
- The strips are arranged at a $45^{\circ}$ angle
- The photos are about 2-1/2" from the bottom edge.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the smaller flowers and butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title and the journaling block.
- Optional: add a stitched line on some of the strips.


## IDEAS:

- Simplify by using one piece of patterned paper with the slanted edges on the right.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Use a single photo, like a $5 \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, in place of the two photos.


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## MEASUREMENTS:

- Smaller hexagons (white): 1-1/2"
- Larger hexagons: $2^{\prime \prime}$
- Photo mat: 5-1/2 $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Journaling block: $3 \times 1$ "


## PLACEMENTS:

- The first column of hexagons on the left are $1^{\prime \prime}$ from the left edge of the layout.
- The photo mat is $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge and $2^{\prime \prime}$ from the right edge.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the flowers and butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched border on some of the hexagons.


## IDEAS:

- Simplify by using one piece of $6 \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ patterned paper in place of the hexagons.
- Try using a different shape like squares, stars, hearts, or strips instead of hexagons
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Use a single photo, like a $5 \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, in place of the two photos.


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## MEASUREMENTS:

- Horizontal strips, top to bottom: both pages -12 x $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 12 \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 12 \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and $12 \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Scallop strips: both pages $-12 \times 1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Large photo mat: both pages $-10-1 / 4 \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Journaling block pieces: 2-1/2 $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $3 \times 4{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- Butterflies: 1/2", 1", 1-1/4", 1-1/2", and 2-1/2"


## PLACEMENTS:

- The photo mat is $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge of the layout.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add some stitched lines on the horizontal strips.


## IDEAS:

- Use a different shape like hearts, stars, or flowers in place of the butterflies.
- Add more photos and extend the photo block to the left and right edges.
- Use one side of the layout to create a one-page layout.
- Shrink the design down to create a one-page layout.

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## MEASUREMENTS:

- Horizontal strips, top to bottom: both pages $-12 \times$ $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}, 12 \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and $12 \times 1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Photo mats: $3-1 / 2 \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Journaling block: $3-1 / 2 \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Easter eggs: 2-1/2 $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$


## PLACEMENTS:

- The $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal strip is $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom of the layout.
- The Easter eggs are centered on the $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal strip and slightly overlapped.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the Easter eggs.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add some stitched lines on the 3-1/2" horizontal strip.


## IDEAS:

- Use a different shape like hearts, stars, or flowers in place of the Easter eggs.
- Simpify by using $3 \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ photos arranged straight and lined up with the edge of the horizontal strips.
- Use one side of the layout to create a one-page layout.

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## MEASUREMENTS:

- Large horizontal strip background: $8-1 / 2 \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- Horizontal strips, top to bottom: $8-1 / 2 \times 3 / 4^{\prime \prime}, 8-1 / 2 \times 1 / 4$ ", $8-1 / 2 \times 3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and $8-1 / 2 \times 1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Large photo mat: $4 \times 8^{\prime \prime}$
- Journaling strips: $1 / 4 \times$ varying lengths


## PLACEMENTS:

- The large horizontal strips background is $3^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge of the layout.
- The $8-1 / 2 \times 1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips are on top of the $8-1 / 2 \times 3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- The photo mat is about $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge and $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the left edge.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the scallop circle and banner piece
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched line on the $8-1 / 2 \times 3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## IDEAS:

- Simplify by using one piece of $8-1 / 2 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ patterned paper in place of the horizontal strips.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Create a two-page layout by adding photos that line up with the horizontal strips.
- Use a single photo, like a $3-1 / 2 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$, in place of two photos.

- Slated squares: 1-1/2"

- The slanted square background is centered, $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the top and bottom edges of the layout.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- The squares are slanted at a $45^{\circ}$ angle.
- Cut squares in half diagnolly for the edge pieces.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller flowers and the bees.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched border to the edges of the slanted squares.


## IDEAS:

- Simplify by using one $8-1 / 2 \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of patterned paper in place of the slanted squares.
- Simplify by using straight squares.
- Try using a different shape like hexagons or triangles in place of the slanted squares.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a photo block that lines up with the slanted squares design.
- Use a single photo, like a $5 \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ or $6 \times 4^{\prime \prime}$, in place of the two photos.

- Card base: $12 \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ - folded into a $6 \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ card
- Slanted hexagon frame: 5"
- Hexagons: 4-3/4" and 4-1/2"

- Sentiment background piece: 2-1/2 x $1^{\prime \prime}$


## PLACEMENTS

- The slanted edge pieces are about $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the top and bottom edges.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller sentiment strip
- Optional: add a stitched border on some of the slanted edge pieces.


## IDEAS:

- Use a differnt shape like squares, triangles, strips, or hexagons in place of the slanted edge strips.

- Card base: $8 \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - folded into a $4 \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cardsolid
- Background piece: $2-3 / 4 \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS

- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller flowers and butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the sentiment.
- Optional: add a stitched border on the 2-3/4" piece.


## IDEAS:

- Use a different shape like a circles, hearts, or stars in place of the flowers.



## MEASUREMENTS:

- Card base: $8 \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - folded into a $4 \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cardsolid
- Background piece: $3-3 / 4 \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Wreath: 3-1/2"


## PLACEMENTS:

- The wreath design is about $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the top and $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the left and right edges.


## ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS

- Use foam adhesive to adhere the wreath design.


## IDEAS:

- Use a differnt shape like hearts, stars, flowers, or vines to create the wreath design.


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
