



• Strips: 1" x varying lengths

• Photo mat: 3 x 4"

• Journaling block: 2-1/2 x 3/4"

## PLACEMENTS:

- The strips come together at the middle (6") point of the layout.
- The strips are arranged at a 45° angle.
- The photos are about 2-1/2" from the bottom edge.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the smaller flowers and butterflies
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title and the journaling block.
- Optional: add a stitched line on some of the strips.

## **IDEAS:**

- Simplify by using one piece of patterned paper with the slanted edges on the right.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Use a single photo, like a 5 x 3-1/2", in place of the two photos.

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- Smaller hexagons (white): 1-1/2"
- Larger hexagons: 2"
- Photo mat: 5-1/2 x 4"
- Journaling block: 3 x 1"

#### PLACEMENTS:


- The first column of hexagons on the left are 1" from the left edge of the layout.
- $\bullet$  The photo mat is 2-1/2" from the bottom edge and 2" from the right edge.

#### **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the flowers and butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched border on some of the hexagons.


#### **IDEAS:**

- Simplify by using one piece of 6 x 12" patterned paper in place of the hexagons.
- Try using a different shape like squares, stars, hearts, or strips instead of hexagons.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Use a single photo, like a 5 x 3-1/2", in place of the two photos.









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# **MEASUREMENTS:**

- Horizontal strips, top to bottom: both pages 12 x 1-1/2", 12 x 1/2", 12 x 1-1/2", and 12 x 1/2"
- Scallop strips: both pages 12 x 1/4"
- Large photo mat: both pages 10-1/4 x 4-1/2"
- Journaling block pieces: 2-1/2 x 3-1/2" and 3 x 4"
- Butterflies: 1/2", 1", 1-1/4", 1-1/2", and 2-1/2"

## **PLACEMENTS:**

• The photo mat is 3-3/4" from the bottom edge of the layout.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add some stitched lines on the horizontal strips.


## **IDEAS:**

- Use a different shape like hearts, stars, or flowers in place of the butterflies.
- Add more photos and extend the photo block to the left and right edges.
- Use one side of the layout to create a one-page layout.
- Shrink the design down to create a one-page layout.

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## **MEASUREMENTS:**

 $\bullet$  Horizontal strips, top to bottom: both pages - 12 x 1/4", 12 x 3-1/2", and 12 x 1/4"

• Photo mats: 3-1/2 x 3-1/2"

• Journaling block: 3-1/2 x 2-3/4"

• Easter eggs: 2-1/2 x 2"

## **PLACEMENTS:**

• The 3-1/2" horizontal strip is 4-1/4" from the bottom of the layout.

• The Easter eggs are centered on the 3-1/2" horizontal strip and slightly overlapped.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the Easter eggs.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add some stitched lines on the 3-1/2" horizontal strip.


# **IDEAS:**

- Use a different shape like hearts, stars, or flowers in place of the Easter eggs.
- $\bullet$  Simpify by using 3 x 3" photos arranged straight and lined up with the edge of the horizontal strips.
- Use one side of the layout to create a one-page layout.

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- Large horizontal strip background: 8-1/2 x 3-1/2"
- Horizontal strips, top to bottom: 8-1/2 x 3/4", 8-1/2 x 1/4", 8-1/2 x 3/4", and 8-1/2 x 1/4"
- Large photo mat: 4 x 8"
- Journaling strips: 1/4 x varying lengths

#### PLACEMENTS:

- The large horizontal strips background is 3" from the bottom edge of the layout.
- The 8-1/2 x 1/4" strips are on top of the 8-1/2 x 3/4" strips.
- The photo mat is about 1-1/2" from the bottom edge and 1-1/4" from the left edge.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere some of the scallop circle and banner piece.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched line on the 8-1/2 x 3/4" strips.

#### **IDEAS:**

- Simplify by using one piece of 8-1/2 x 5" patterned paper in place of the horizontal strips.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Create a two-page layout by adding photos that line up with the horizontal strips.
- Use a single photo, like a 3-1/2 x 5", in place of two photos.









Slated squares: 1-1/2"
Photo mats: 3-1/4 x 3-1/4"
Journaling block: 2-3/4 x 1-1/2"

#### PLACEMENTS:

• The slanted square background is centered, 1-1/4" from the top and bottom edges of the layout.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- The squares are slanted at a 45° angle.
- Cut squares in half diagnolly for the edge pieces.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller flowers and the bees.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the title.
- Optional: add a stitched border to the edges of the slanted squares.

#### **IDEAS:**

- Simplify by using one 8-1/2 x 8-1/2" piece of patterned paper in place of the slanted squares.
- Simplify by using straight squares.
- Try using a different shape like hexagons or triangles in place of the slanted squares.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a large photo block on the opposite page.
- Create a two-page layout by extending the design across both pages.
- Create a two-page layout by adding a photo block that lines up with the slanted squares design.
- Use a single photo, like a 5 x 3" or 6 x 4", in place of the two photos.

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• Card base: 12 x 6" - folded into a 6 x 6" card

Slanted hexagon frame: 5"Hexagons: 4-3/4" and 4-1/2"

## **PLACEMENTS**:

• The two hexagon pieces are centered on the card.


# **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller flowers.
- Optional: add a stitched border on the smallest hexagon piece.

## **IDEAS:**

 $\bullet$  Use a different shape like a circle, heart, star, or triangle in place of the hexagons.





## **MEASUREMENTS:**

• Card base: 5-1/2 x 8" - folded into a 5-1/2 x 4" card

• Slanted edge pieces: 5/8 x 1-1/4"

• Sentiment background piece: 2-1/2 x 1"

#### PLACEMENTS:


• The slanted edge pieces are about 1/2" from the top and bottom edges.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**


- Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller sentiment strip.
- Optional: add a stitched border on some of the slanted edge pieces.

## **IDEAS:**

• Use a differnt shape like squares, triangles, strips, or hexagons in place of the slanted edge strips.







• Card base: 8 x 5-1/2" - folded into a 4 x 5-1/2" card

• Background piece: 2-3/4 x 5-1/2"


# **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

- $\bullet$  Use foam adhesive to adhere the smaller flowers and butterflies.
- Use foam adhesive to adhere the sentiment.
- Optional: add a stitched border on the 2-3/4" piece.

• Use a different shape like a circles, hearts, or stars in place of the flowers.

# **MEASUREMENTS:**

• Card base: 8 x 5-1/2" - folded into a 4 x 5-1/2" card

• Background piece: 3-3/4 x 5-1/4"

• Wreath: 3-1/2"

# PLACEMENTS:

 $\bullet$  The wreath design is about 1/2" from the top and 1/4" from the left and right edges.

## **ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:**

• Use foam adhesive to adhere the wreath design.

#### **IDEAS:**

• Use a differnt shape like hearts, stars, flowers, or vines to create the wreath design.
