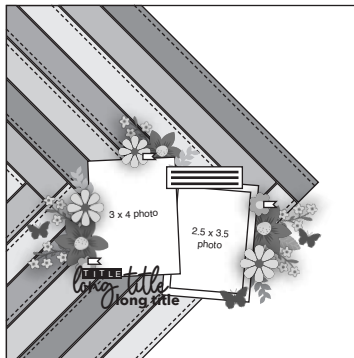


Creating with SKETCHES

BONUS SKETCH OPTIONS

A visual example of the many adaptations you can make to help the sketch better fit your needs.

ORIGINAL SKETCH



changing the PAPERS

The following examples show different ways you can adapt the papers on the sketch to either simplify or enhance the design.

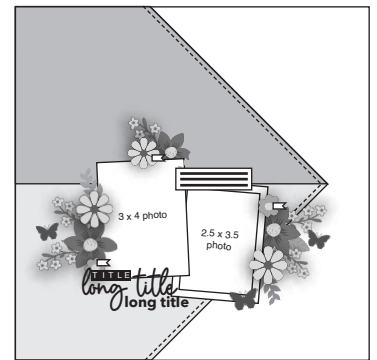
OPTION #1

Simplify by using a single angled piece in place of the strips.



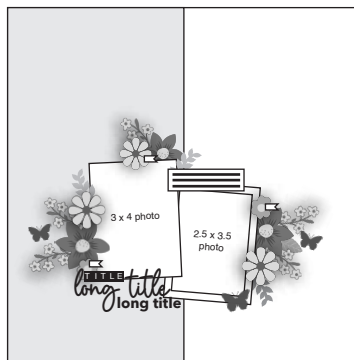
OPTION #2

Simplify by using two larger slanted pieces together.



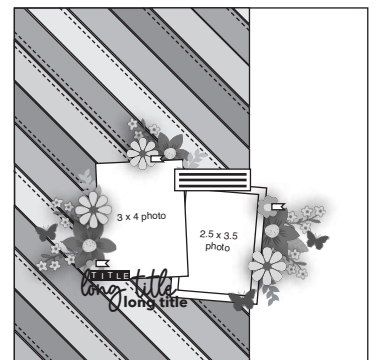
OPTION #3

Simplify by using a straight rectangle piece.



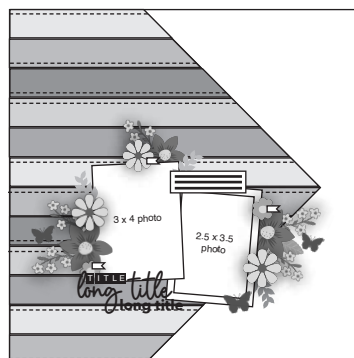
OPTION #4

Use slanted strips to create a rectangle background.



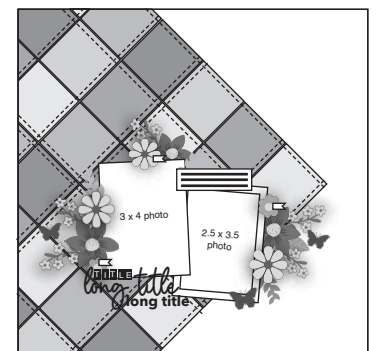
OPTION #5

Use straight strips in place of the angled strips.



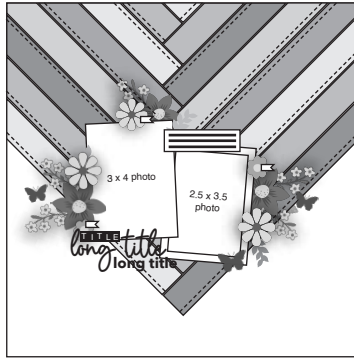
OPTION #6

Use a different shape like squares, diamonds, or hexagons in place of the strips.



OPTION #7

Rotate the sketch.

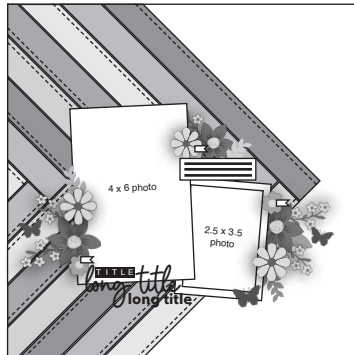


changing the PHOTOS

The following examples show different photo sizes that can work with this two photo sketch design without changing the number of photos.

OPTION #8

Use a larger photo like a 3 x 5" or 4 x 6" in place of one photo.



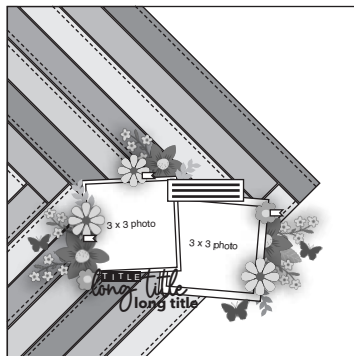
OPTION #9

Use two larger photos like 3 x 5" or 4 x 6".



OPTION #10

Use two smaller photos like 2-1/2 x 2-1/2" or 3 x 3".

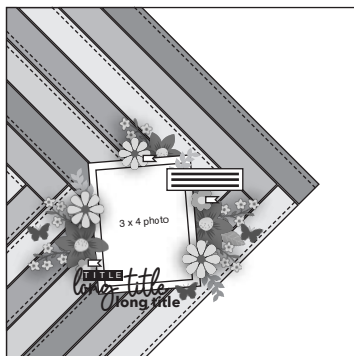


using less PHOTOS

The following examples show to adjust the sketch to work with less photos, most often by removing photos or using larger photos.

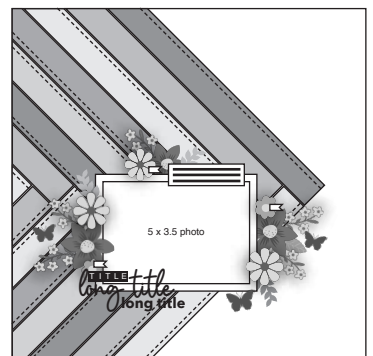
OPTION #11

Use just one of the two photos.



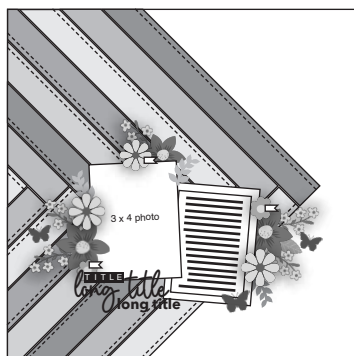
OPTION #12

Use one larger photo in place of the two photos.



OPTION #13

Replace one photo with a larger journaling space.

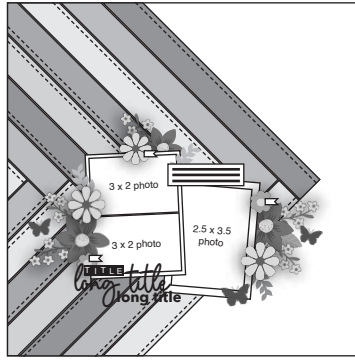


adding more PHOTOS

The following examples show how to adjust the sketch to work with more photos, most often by extending or using smaller photos.

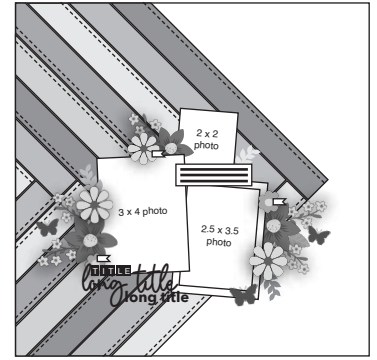
OPTION #14

Use two 3 x 2" photos in place of the 3 x 4" photo.



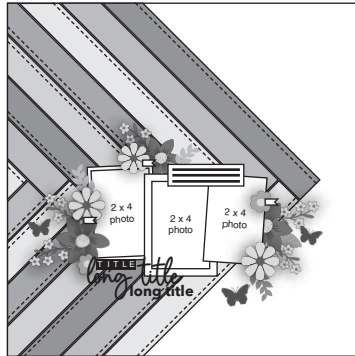
OPTION #15

Add a small accent photo.



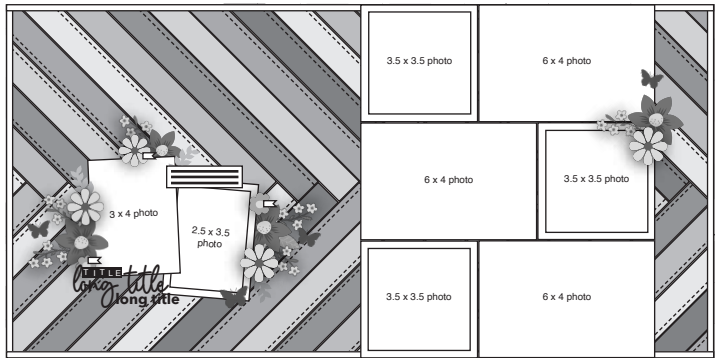
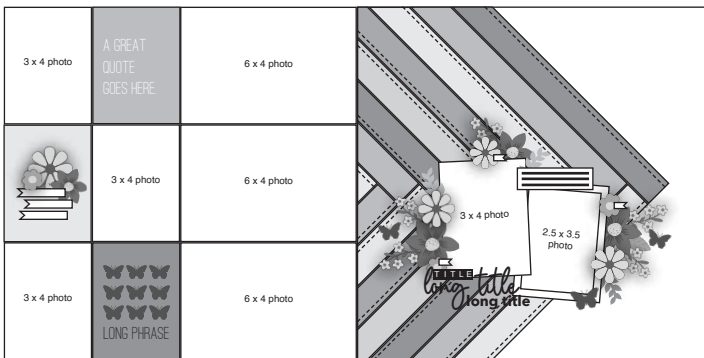
OPTION #16

Use three smaller photos.



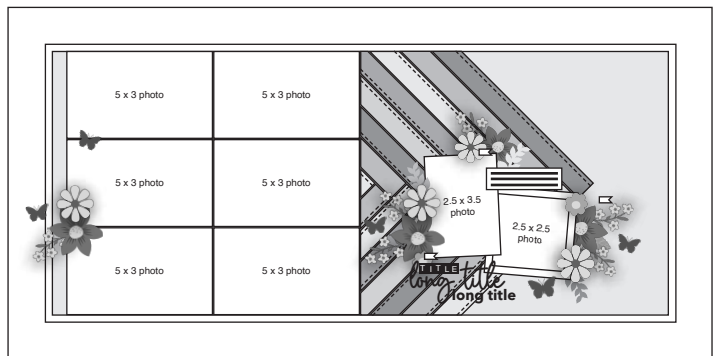
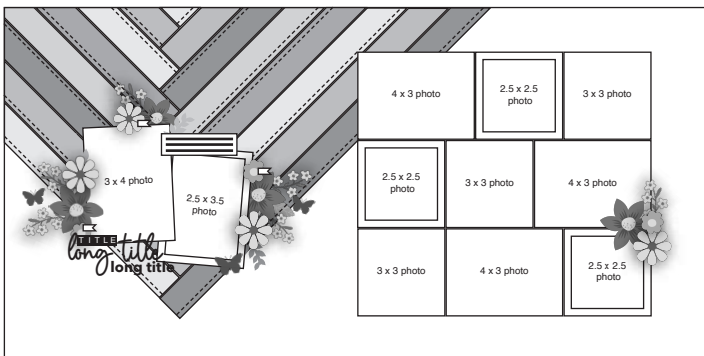
changing the **SIZE**

The following examples show how to adjust the one-page sketch to work as a two-page design using a variety of methods.



OPTION #24 - Add a large photo block on the opposite page.

OPTION #25 - Extend the background strips across both pages and add a large photo block.



OPTION #24 - Rotate the sketch and add a large photo block on the opposite page.

OPTION #25 - Shrink the slanted strips design down and add a photo block that lines up with the edges of it.

Each of these examples can work alone, but for even more options try mixing and matching two examples together. The possibilities are endless!
