
# creating with sketches





Brighten up those holiday colours! Pops of bright pink and chartreuse make for a very fun, surprising Christmas palette.




#### **DESIGN TIP:**

#### Incorporate patterned paper into your card designs.

The tone-on-tone patterns add a subtle visual texture, and the papers as a whole add lovely blocks of colour.





## play with quadrants

#### Our final sketch incorporates lots of lines and four distinct sections.

For her first card, Allison added a string of Christmas lights to create the strong horizontal line and her festive birdhouse bisects it to make the four quadrants. On her second card, the grass becomes the horizon line in her homey scene, and the house and sidewalk stand in for the vertical line. Such a clever way to approach this sketch!
