NOT JUST FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Get festive all year 'round! Once you learn this fun technique, you can switch up the size and the patterned paper to make a display on other layouts or even on a wall. Large rosettes would be really fun for a baby shower, a birthday party, or for just about any celebration!

deck the halls

supplies PATTERNED PAPER, EPHEMERA, STICKERS: Paige Evans for American Crafts; ADHESIVE: American Crafts

THE FOCUS:

Pretty paper rosettes are the focus of this issue.

The more patterned papers I can include on a layout, the merrier, and paper rosettes are an easy way to do just that! Placing them in a beautiful wreath drives home the holiday look and feel.

PAIGE POINTERS:

- Pick five papers for each rosette and trim to 2 x 3.
- Score the papers every ¼ inch and then fold accordion style.
- Connect the papers end-to-end.
- Press the rosettes down onto a circle of cardstock and glue in place.
- Repeat 5 times for 5 rosettes!
- Place the rosettes in a wreath and then feature a photo in the center of the wreath.
- Add a title at the top around a curved part.
- Embellish with coordinating ephemera and stickers.
- Sprinkle enamel dots around the page to finish!
