

student supplies checklist



For each class, there is a **Student Supplies list**. We understand you may not have everything on hand, and we encourage you to substitute where you are able to. Here is the master checklist to help you prepare. This incorporates all of the Student Supplies from each of the classes.

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

- Die cut machine
- Paper trimmer, pencil, ruler, scissors
- Acrylic blocks (large and small) or stamping platform
- Adhesive: Foam tape, runner, liquid
- Black ink compatible with alcohol markers
- Paper towel
- Small spray bottle
- Adhesive eraser
- Embossing ink
- White embossing powder
- Heat embossing tool
- 1.75-inch and 2.5-inch circle punch or die
- 1/4-inch hole punch
- Flat paintbrush (1/2-inch suggested)
- Round paintbrush or waterbrush
- Corner rounder
- Craft mat (or piece of acetate or plastic packaging)

SUGGESTED SUPPLIES (but not required):

- Stamping platform
- Powder tool
- Scoring tool

INK PAD COLOURS (not brand specific):

- Yellow, Orange, Red, Light Green, Dark Green, Turquoise, Light Pink, Dark Pink, Light Gray, Black (alcohol marker friendly).

Following are the actual ink or colouring medium each instructor is using in the event you have these inks on hand or wish to use the same:

Gina Krupsky uses the following Gina K. Designs ink pads:

- Red Velvet, Tangerine Twist, Wild Dandelion, Jelly Bean Green, Fresh Asparagus, Turquoise Sea, Passionate Pink, Dusty Rose, Black Onyx, Soft Stone

Jill Broadbent uses the following Close To My Heart ink pads:

- Sundance, Fern, Black

Jenn Shurkus uses the following Lawn Fawn ink pads:

- Merman, Jet Black

Jenn Shurkus will also be using the following Copic markers:

- RV10, RV21, R35, YR14, Y13, B00, V15, V12, E33, E37, W2, W6 (if using colouring medium other than Copics ie: pencil crayons, you will need pink, red, brown, orange, purple, yellow, light blue, dk gray, light gray)

Cathy Zielske uses the following ink colours:

- Three to five dye-based ink pads in red/pink, orange, yellow, green, blue, or purple. Cathy is using Gina K. Designs ink pads in Dusty Rose, Sweet Mango, Wild Dandelion, Jelly Bean Green and Ocean Mist.
- You'll also need 1/2 sheet of cardstock in either pink, green, light blue or yellow to match the paper you choose from the Your Next Stamp paper pad in your kit.

Becky Moore suggests a basic watercolour set (or Tim Holtz Distress Ink pads) and dye-based ink pads in floral colours in pink, blue, yellow, green, orange, red.

Libby Hickson uses the following Hero Arts ink:

- Black Ink, Exclusive 5-Colour Reactive Ink pad included in your kit.
