



Here is a list of the supplies that Andrea will be using in class. Remember, you do not need the exact products that Andrea is using, however, as the class progresses, Andrea will be using more tools to create her mini albums. You can choose to purchase yours in advance, or wait until the lesson is released and then decide what you want to purchase. Photos were not added to the list, but you can add these after the album has been created!

Lesson one

Andrea includes a list of supplies and tools that can be used for mini album making. This entire list is not required for this class, but shows the variety of materials and tools that you can use to create your mini albums.

Lesson two

In lesson two, Andrea will be creating with the Gingham Gardens collection from Maggie Holmes & Crate Paper.

- Cardstock or patterned paper
- Adhesive (glue, double-sided tape, or adhesive dots)
- Embellishments (stickers, die-cuts, chipboard shapes, etc.)
- Ribbon or twine
- Paper trimmer and scissors
- Scoring board or bone folder
- Measuring tools

Lesson three

In lesson three, Andrea will be creating with the Sugar Rush collection from Vicki Boutin and American Crafts.

- 2mm chipboard
- Cardstock, patterned paper, vellum, or acetate

- Adhesive (Glue, double-sided tape, or adhesive dots)
- Embellishments (stickers, die-cuts, chipboard shapes, etc.)
- Ribbon or twine
- Metal rings
- Paper trimmer or scissors
- Single hole punch or Crop-A-Dile/Multi Punch
- Metal dies and die cutting machine and/or electronic die cutting machine

Lesson four

In lesson four, Andrea will be using the Let's Go, Wildflower and Boho Sunshine collections by Simple Stories.

- 2mm chipboard
- Cardstock or patterned paper
- Paper trimmer
- Hole punch or bookbinding machine, like the We R Makers Multi Cinch
- Rings, discs or spirals
- Scissors
- Adhesive (glue, double-sided tape, or adhesive dots)
- Measuring tools
- Embellishments (stickers, die-cuts, chipboard shapes, etc.)
- Bookbinding tools*



Lesson five

In lesson five, Andrea will be using the Harvest Market collection from Simple Stories.

- 2mm chipboard
- Cardstock or patterned paper
- Adhesive (glue, double-sided tape, or adhesive dots)
- Embellishments (stickers, die-cuts, chipboard shapes and frames, etc.)
- Ribbon
- Paper trimmer and scissors
- Scoring board or bone folder
- Measuring tools
- Bookbinding tools*

* Note regarding bookbinding tools:

In the last three lessons, Andrea will use tools, such as an "I" rule, "L" rules, "T" square and a corner miter to create her mini albums. These are not required, but do help in the creative process.

Andrea purchased a kit with all of her tools from Etsy seller CraftyShopbySache, and you can find the kit that she purchased by clicking the image on the right. You can also find these items listed individually in the shop.

- 2mm chipboard
- Cardstock, patterned paper, vellum, or acetate
- Adhesive (Glue, double-sided tape, or adhesive dots)
- Embellishments (stickers, die-cuts, chipboard shapes, etc.)
- Elastic cord
- Eyelets & eyelet setter
- Paper trimmer and scissors
- Single hole punch or Crop-A-Dile/Multi Punch
- Measuring tools
- Bookbinding tools*
