

pocket play

Short on time? Here you'll find creative ideas to make the most of your pocket pages. By LISA WILLIAMS VARSHINE

Almost three years ago (shortly after having our second child), I started scrapbooking.

I was tired of having all of these wonderful photographs and memories trapped in my phone and doomed to never see the light of day. In the beginning, memory keeping was a great creative outlet, but it has become so much more for me! Documenting our lives in each of these pages has become a way to practice gratitude, which offers me a tangible reminder of everything I have to be thankful for.



TIPS

POCKET TIP #1: Use a mix of photos—some that include people and some that don't. Even though these pages tell the story of my family, I like to include a variety of photos that don't include people. I'm also aware of a balance of portraits to groups and activities, and even close-up shots.

POCKET TIP #2: Get creative with your journaling.

I printed my journaling on the computer using two different methods. I printed the longer journaling on vellum and stapled it to a 4 x 6 card. I also printed some journaling on white paper and cut it into strips for visual interest. To sneak in a few more words, I used a digital tag from Ali Edwards.

Fall is by far my favorite time of year. In this two-page 12 x 12 spread, I documented a typical fall week for our family. I love looking back on the beauty of those ordinary days and capturing a snapshot of a week in our life. On a spread like this, I'm able to include everything from school field trips to pumpkin carving to simple outside playtime.

BONUS TIP: Think outside the pocket (sort of).

Sometimes I take a picture I really love, and I instantly know that it needs to be bigger than the rest of the photos in my spread. I thought it would be fun to print the strong landscape photo of my kids checking out a huge spread of pumpkins at 9×3 and then trim it to fit into a row of three pockets. On other spreads I've even printed a photo at 12 x 3 to go across the whole page!

I grew up in Florida, so my first visit to a pumpkin patch was as an adult after we had my daughter. I instantly fell in love. My kids feel the same way, and visiting the same pumpkin patch every fall has become a tradition for our family. I loved putting together a one-page spread that lets me include all the photos I want!

POCKET TIP #1: Create harmony with your colour

choices. Take a look at your photos and search for products that not only convey the theme, but continue the colour scheme to create a pleasing result. My photos led me to choose rich oranges and muted greens to further the fall-like theme.

POCKET TIP #2: Edit your photos. I love the bold and bright colors of these photos from the pumpkin patch which I achieved by making quick and easy edits with various apps on my smart phone. Because they were shot in great light (outside on a sunny day), they didn't need much, but just a tweak of the contrast, a bump of saturation and exposure make a world of difference.

DESIGN TIP: Who knew pink could work so well for fall? Paige drew inspiration from the colours of the leaves and her daughter's shirt in the photographs.



add stitching to a cut file

Spend some quality time with your sewing machine and add pretty gold stitching to a leaf cut file created with a gradient patterned paper. Once you've finished stitching each leaf, arrange them into a stunning fall wreath, and tuck in some of your favourite fall photos.

DESIGN TIP: Instead of actual stitching with a sewing machine, you could pen stitch or simply hand-stitch a few of the leaves instead of all of them.

STEP-BY-STEP

Let's take a closer look at how Sheri created her handmade embellishments:



 Die cut circles from cork and patterned paper. Cut patterned paper circle in half and adhere one half to the bottom portion of cork circle. Wrap with crochet thread and secure with adhesive on back.




2 Apply foam tape to back of circle and secure paper clip to back so that only a small loop is visible. Punch scalloped circle and adhere cork portion to it.



3 Add enamel heart and sentiment sticker, and adhere to layout with foam tape.





DESIGN TIP: If you're looking for design inspiration, rely on a sketch! Meghann's layout is based on the PageMap from our summer issue's call for submissions.

DESIGN TIP: Design your own embellishments based on the colours in your photos or the product of your choice!

raid your stash

Meghann had a blast creating her three one-of-a-kind embellishments with a variety of goodies she found in her stash. Look closely, and you'll see decorative tape, punched shapes, tulle, thread, and glitter! The colourful row of books that intersects her layout meshes well with her unique Meghann-made designs.

Collections are created to mix and match perfectly, so layer up various circles in different patterns. You can add interest with dies that have stitched edges and zigzags, too. Spread out the goodies from the collection on your craft table and see what things you can pair to create your own little bit of cuteness.

DESIGN TIP: The enamel dots that Latisha added to her finished card not only give a lot of movement to the design, but they perfectly emulate the dots in her focal embellishment!

happy halloween

STEP-BY-STEP Let's see how Latisha created her spooky cute handmade embellishment:



Die cut three sizes of circles from patterned papers and cardstock. Mix faux stitched details with scalloped edged.




2 Adhere three circles to each other with foam tape to add dimension. NOTE: Latisha used black foam squares which work well for this Halloween theme.



3 Tie twine around clip in a bow and slide onto circle; adhere sticker.

DESIGN TIP: For more handmade goodness, add stitching to die cut leaves. The texture is out of this world!



create a shaker element

Using two die cut shapes, Maryám fashioned a one-of-a-kind embellishment with sequins,

and she added more flair with a die cut bow and a sticker to zhuzh it up even more. This pretty little shaker was the perfect spot for the date that she added with a date stamp.

DESIGN TIP: Frame it! The expanse of Maryám's background is tamed and framed with a thin wooden square that allows her to ground the two gorgeous groupings of leaves and fall-themed goodies

hello fall







Ashlea's second card showcases another way of looking at the sketch. Flip it on the side and focus on the background in an understated and gorgeous gold-on-white design. The lovely gathering of colourful leaves (paying homage to the sun featured in the sketch) stands out brilliantly against the bold sentiment.

DESIGN TIP: Add gorgeous autumnal texture with trim and dry embossing.

design 101: why it works

Let's study the hows and whys that separate just okay design from great design! BY SUSAN R. OPEL

Want to know why it works when a design comes together? Delve into the minds of two designers and their creative processes and learn some fantastic rules for making your next layout a phenomenal success!

layout 1

Create balance.

Balance a heavy element (the bottom photo) with a cluster of embellishments in the opposite corner (tab/sticker/ tape/flower).

Select a palette • of analogous

colours (those right next to each other on the colour wheel) for a harmonious feel. In this design, Lisa chose orange for Halloween but softened the look by adding pink and red.



Go beyond the grid. Let some page elements break out of the arid for a fun. whimsical look that also helps soften all the straight lines & right angles.

Pour on texture and detail. Give your design a handmade feel (and bonus texture!) with subtle stitching.

Ground your layout with a grid foundation. You'll have a solid base to build a design upon!

Add dimension. Use embellishments in the same colour palette as the grid block they'll be adhered to and use foam adhesive to help them pop.

Edit your photos. Change your photos to black and white to disguise photos that may not coordinate with your products.

Layer it up. Add • charming texture by layering different patterns and tearing the edges.

Ground your design.

Use a subtle patterned paper background to add texture and small amounts of color to frame the focal portion of your layout.

Go BOLD. Create a succinct and dominant title that commands attention.

Get artistic. Add • watercolours to the flowers for added colour and interest! Addison's sweet and delicate smile She really is a natural beauty

DESIGN LINGO 101 Grounding is a term used a lot in design, and simply put, it refers to creating a space to contain page elements—photos, journaling, embellishments—and to give them a direct relationship to one another. Whether you group all of your elements into a large central area as Nicole did or just use the background paper itself, grounding creates a sense of unity on any scrapbook layout.

Add colourful interest. Adhere strips of patterned papers to disperse the colour around the page without being overbearing to the design as a whole.

What is the scope of your next layout? Determining whether you will take a sweeping view of a single topic or event will produce different results than taking a very specific view from the same topic or event. Either choice helps determine the direction your story will take.

DESIGN TIP: Work in rainbow order.

I cut scraps of patterned paper starting with black then following the rainbow order for orange, green, and purple. These classic Halloween colours work as a triadic scheme on the colour wheel.

A SWEEPING STORY The topic for my first layout is Halloween.

I wanted to document how my family has celebrated over the years. By taking an expanded view of an arguably large amount of time, I can include many photos spanning multiple years and add a short synopsis of my main theme for my journaling.

STORY TIP: Let the photos tell the story. With 12 shots all focused on the same theme, there is no need for expansive journaling. Keep it short and sweet!

PRODUCT TIP: Make quick work of adhering die

cut letters with a Xyron Sticker Maker. Just feed them through the top, pull out through the bottom, and just like that—instant stickers ready for your project!



One of my favorite things about designing a mini album is the ability to tell a story or record a memory all in one sitting. With this approach, I can share my feelings on a certain subject with my kids. For this album, I really wanted my son to remember the special blessing of family, so I approached my journaling and selected my photos based on this theme. This goes a little bit deeper than just telling what we did. It's more about making the connection to how I hope he feels about these family activities.

MINI SIZE: $4\frac{1}{2} \times 8$



MAKE IT TIP: Get your kids involved. Have them list 5-7 things they are grateful for and then print photos and journaling to fit their choices. They can even help assemble the album for Thanksgiving as part of a new family tradition.

GETTING STARTED

The pages of my mini album were created from a large tag die from Scrapbook.com. This particular die set includes several different sizes of tags, so you could make different sizes of albums as well as add smaller tag elements to your album. Look for basic shape dies to create a unique sized album.

MAKE IT TIP: Create a custom "binding." Hold your tag album together with a binder ring and tie it with a pretty bow that coordinates. Mini albums are the perfect way to use up those bits and bobs you've been saving.

MAKE IT TIP: Make your title stand out. To give the title more presence, I added both a fussy cut title from a journaling card and a layered die cut word. I distressed the word blessed with brown stamping ink.

MAKE IT TIP: Add depth and details. Add depth and interest to your journaling strips by distressing the edges and add layers and texture with die cuts leaves and bits of twine to give your mini album a homey feel.

MAKE IT TIP: Stretch your

supplies. While this collection from Echo Park has lots of coordinating embellishments you can purchase and add to the album, I also used fussy cut images from the patterned paper to create my own unique embellishments.





MAKE IT TIP: Add interactive elements. I created an accordion fold out for one page of my album. I did this by cutting out an entire strip of journaling cards from patterned paper. I folded the strip as an accordion and then added photos, stickers, and embellishments to the fold out.

MAKE IT TIP: Share your

voice. Heartfelt journaling might not come naturally, and you might not think you're an incredible writer, but your audience (in this case my son) will appreciate hearing YOU in the words that you share.
